Pillowcases for The Wishing Well Foundation

The Wishing Well Foundation (caring for the needs of foster children, <u>http://www.thewishingwellwa.org/</u>) needs pillowcase bags for the children they help.

These pillowcases are similar to the ones we are already used to making - burrito style. The body is 27 inches, the flange is 3 inches, and the finished cuff is 5 inches (cut 10 inches). Feel free to fudge no more than an inch or two on the body and cuff to maximize fabric available. Please do not fudge on the flange. The length of the flange is 1 1/2 inches shorter than the width of the fabric on both sides. Turn it under twice and sew to create a finished edge (see photos).

For these pillowcases, the flange will be topped stitched down to the body, creating a casing. Drawstring cording will be added later. Sew the CTA label to the inside of the pillowcase

Here are pictures of the finished product, except we are going to use cording.
