

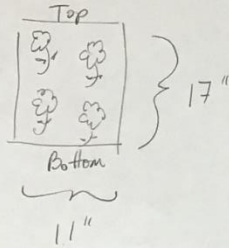
Utensil Roll

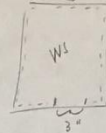
Materials: Fabric: Outer: ① 11" x 17" *
 Lining: ① 11" x 17"
 (Optional: Napkin 16" square)
 Tie/Ribbon: 28"

* For directional fabrics:



Sew

1. Sew Outer + Lining RS together - $\frac{3}{8}$ " SA - leaving 3" opening @ bottom edge.



2. Clip corners + turn RS mt. Press

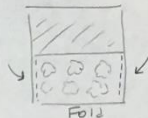
3. Topstitch close to edge, all the way around.



4. Lining-side up, bring bottom edge up to form a 6" pocket

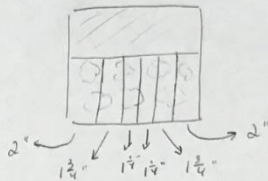


5. Topstitch edges close to edges.

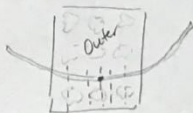


(I did a bartack @ top corners to reinforce.)

6. Mark & sew slots



7. Flip over. Mark center of roll or closest slot seam. Place center of tie on top of this and stitch down securely.



• Hem napkin if desired
 • Fill roll, wrap + tie.
 • Done!
