Total of 7 drawers.	<p>Ebay-1 treadle with furniture from estate sale sold for \$500 (priced at \$569). On Bonanza web site found a treadle machine/furniture was selling for \$225</p> <p>Ebay-W&W carved felt lined box dated 1887-1905.
